4 **COMPULSORY** essay questions **AND**

1 **COMPULSORY** question comprising 2 or more sectional radiographs from which the candidate will be expected to name the structures indicated.

ALL questions will be of equal value.

Syllabus

Aim

To ensure the candidate has a working knowledge of anatomy that will provide a foundation for more detailed knowledge as it applies to clinical oncological practice.

Areas examined

Specifically in addition to general anatomy the candidate is expected to have -

Detailed knowledge of head and neck anatomy

Detailed knowledge of the anatomical relations of organs

Detailed knowledge of lymphatic drainage

Detailed knowledge of the major anatomical structures of the head, neck, chest, abdomen and pelvis as demonstrated in normal CT, MRI or plain radiographs. Candidates should seek the assistance of a radiologist for this section of the syllabus.

Basic knowledge of surface anatomy.
